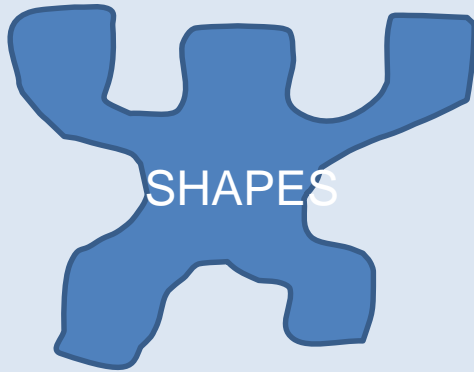

- A **FEELING** TYPE PERSON DOES THINGS BASED ON AN EMOTION OR FEELING.
